

## Declaration on conflict of interests for BM-Publisher Journals Title of paper (article, case study, letter review, etc.....) All articles for BM-Publisher Journals require a declaration on any conflict of interests. The most important element of our policy is that all authors, editors, members, and referees must disclose any association that poses a financial conflict of interest in connection with the manuscript. A conflict of interests exists whenever an author has a financial or personal relationship with a third party whose interests could be positively or negatively influenced by the article's contents: Contracts of employment; financial relationships with companies whose products are involved in the article; reimbursements of travel expenses; study sponsorships or other types of third party funding links to health insurance funds or other interest groups; consultancies and speaker's fees. The corresponding author must ensure that all authors have been asked to disclose any conflicts of interest. The following are examples of disclosure statements. 1. The author(s) of this (publication, article or review) has research support from (Source of research funding). The terms of this arrangement have been reviewed and approved by the University of Texas at Austin in accordance with its policy on objectivity in research. 2. If there is no conflict of interest, this must be stated explicitly.
